By submitting an abstract you have agreed to Terms and Conditions.

1. The poster session is dedicated to research related to cancer biology and oncology, including immuno-oncology and related translational research.
2. The poster session is intended for early-career researchers, including young scientists, PhD candidates (doctoral students), postdoctoral researchers (up to 3 years after PhD defense) and master students.
3. Participants must be actively involved in the research presented and listed as authors of the poster.
4. The conference registration system and abstract submission system are available on the website: [www.canvas.ug.edu.pl](http://www.canvas.ug.edu.pl). All abstracts must be submitted online through the registration system.
5. The deadline for abstract submission is 2 March 2026.
6. By submitting an abstract, the author agrees to give the Organizers permission on behalf of all co-authors to publish, reproduce, distribute, display, and store the abstract, together with the names of the author(s) after the acceptance of the abstract for the presentation.
7. Authors declare that they have proprietary copyrights or necessary licenses to the submitted and then published materials and that the publication of the materials and their content is lawful and does not infringe the rights or goods of third parties.
8. The abstracts will be reviewed and accepted by the Scientific Committee.
9. Decisions on acceptance or rejection for the poster session will be sent to the authors of the abstracts by email no later than 3 March 2026.
10. At least one author of each accepted abstract must be available to present the poster. By participating in the poster session, the participant agrees to the processing of personal data (name, surname, e-mail address, affiliation) by the Organizer for the purpose of organizing the poster session.
11. The Abstract Book will be available as a PDF file on the web page [www.canvas.ug.edu.pl](http://www.canvas.ug.edu.pl).
12. The Evaluation Committee (at least (4) members) will assess poster presentations conducted at the time specified in the official conference schedule. Each presenter will be allotted 5 minutes for the poster presentation, followed by a 5-minute discussion and question period.

13. During the Conference, a competition for the Best Scientific Poster will be held. The winner(s) of the Best Poster Award will be announced during the Closing Session of the Conference.
14. Each poster should include the following sections: Title, Authors and Affiliations, Introduction/Background, Objectives/Aims, Materials and Methods/Methodology, Results, and Conclusions.
15. Posters should meet the following technical requirements: maximum dimensions: 70 cm x 150 cm and vertical orientation.
16. Poster boards will be marked with numbers corresponding to the poster numbers listed in the detailed conference program.
17. Posters must be mounted and removed at the times specified in the conference program. The Organizer is not responsible for posters left after the designated removal time.
